- How to engage with the local Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) offices for assistance in finding infant formula substitutes that may not have been previously covered by the program;
- How to enroll families that are not yet WIC participants; and
- How to directly reach out to infant formula manufacturers for specialty formulas.
